### **Checking in**

You must check-in your child to every training session and fixture, home and away. This forms a vital part of our COVID-19 guidelines.

The quickest and easiest way to check in is through the Teamo app - select the session your child is attending and click check-in. This is available to all registered players from 3 hours before the session starts.

Alternatively, you can the QR code at the pitch, this option is not available for away fixtures. Spectators do not need to check in.

Marking you intend to play in Teamo is NOT the same as checking-in to the session.

Please do not drop off your child unless they have been checked in.

# One way system at OCs

The OCs car park is now one-way to reduce congestion. Please enter from Portsmouth Road and exit through the car park, past the football club. This brings you out onto Longmead Road, from where you can turn left onto Weston Green Road.

### One way system at Manor Road pitch

To improve the flow of players on to and off the pitch, we have introduced a new one way system. Please enter the pitch through the usual gate and we will ask players to exit at the end of their session using the gate at the far end. Please collect your children from this exit.

# No spectators in compound or grandstand at OCs

To aid social distancing, please do not remain in the compound area at OCs after dropping off or collecting your child. The grandstand is also now out of use. We would urge all parents watching training or fixtures to observe social distancing rules and recent comply with the most Government guidance.

# Dentist mouthgaurds

For those struggling with the 'boil and bite' mouthguards, a dentist moulded mouthguard can be the solution. Due to COVID-19 we aren't able to offer this service at the club but Anand Patel, who usually visits the club, is offering members a professionally moulded mouthguard at a reduced price of £85, when quoting code OC20. # Midweek training available

For U10s and above we offer midweek training which can be added to your child's membership for an additional fee of £80. As many Sunday sessions will be taken up with fixtures, the midweek session important element of the coaches' training training programme.

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# **COVID-19** guidelines

Our COVID-19 guidelines can be found <u>here</u> and it's important you take time to read them if you haven't already done so.

This season it is essential your child is registered in the Teamo app and your contact details are up to date in your guardian profile.



Please read our guide to checking in on the next page, this forms a vital part of our COVID-19 guidelines and we need all players to check in every time they attend training or a fixture.



At away fixtures, we remain responsible for ensuring all of our players, coaches and umpires have checked in. Please do this through the Teamo app (instructions on next page) to ensure your child is correctly registered. The local club you are visiting may also ask you to check in and we would ask you to respectfully follow their local COVID-19 guidelines as well.



To help social distancing, players from U10s and above can be dropped off at training. In case of an accident, you must be within 10 minutes of the club and contactable on the mobile number registered in Teamo and LoveAdmin. Please ensure these details are up to date. If you are dropping your child at training, it is very important they have already been checked in to the session.



If you decide to stay and watch a training session or fixture, please adhere to the latest Government guidance on social distancing. Note - we have made the decision not to allow spectators in the compound at OCs, including the grandstand, to make social distancing easier.

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# Registering & checking in on Teamo

- The instructions below assume your child is registered in Teamo
- Only players, coaches and umpires need to check in



### Step 1 - Let us know you plan to attend

Let the coaches know whether your child can attend training or a fixture by clicking the green tick or red cross next to the session date. This helps the coaches plan the session or select teams.

This is different to the step below.



#### Step 2 - Check in to the session

All players must check in to the session, this is an essential part of our COVID-19 guidelines. **This is different to the step above.** There are two ways to do this:



### **Check in using Teamo app**

- Open training session or fixture in Teamo
- Look for Teamo PlaySafe logo - next to this is a

#### check-in button

- Click on the check-in button and complete
- You can check in from 3 hours before the session
- You need to be registered in Teamo to use this option
- You must use this option at away fixtures



or

Check in using QR code


- Use your phone's camera to scan the QR code at the pitch
- You do not need to be registered in Teamo to use this method
- This option is not available at away fixtures

### Astros - any size/brand


- Give them a quick clean
