Coaches Corner - Dean Wheeler (Director of Hockey) - Positions on the Pitch

Last week we tried to run a session to enable the kids to understand and have a clearer picture of what to do when we go to competitions and tournaments or when we play matches against other clubs.

In essence we wanted to have a lot of game time and stop the kids and talk about game play, positional awareness and some rules that are used in matches.

In 7 aside matches we will generally play with a 2-3-2 formation IF we do not have a goalkeeper that would be 2 defenders (left and right) 3 midfielders (left, right and center) and 2 forwards/attackers (left and right).

It's really important that we try and get our kids to understand how they will play in matches and competitions and it's up to us all to reinforce these ideas and rules so they become more aware, if you have any questions regarding this please talk to one of your coaches or me, Gav or Cato.
