Thanks to the parents and supporters for conquering the rain and traffic to Chiswick so that the epic U10 OC 1's and 2's could play in our first tournament of the season



Coaches Corner - Dean Wheeler (Director of Hockey) - Competitive Hockey

With matches and competitions against other clubs coming thick and fast teams in diff age groups at the club are getting a really good experience of match/game play in competitive situations.

We need to try and remember things that have been taught to us by your coaches in tra sessions on Sunday mornings. It's really important to start understanding how to play team and how you play your position in matches. Getting used to and knowing the rule really help as well in your development as a hockey player.

We need to try and use the space better when playing matches and not all just follow o chase the ball. When we get the ball in a game the 1st thing we should think is "where next pass" and "who is free on my team I can pass to" before we think about dribbling. need to try and get the ball into a good position in the D (scoring area) where we can the take a shot at goal.
